The responsibilities for this Underwriting role include but are not limited to:

- Reviewing policy applications including Member profiles, claims history, and inspection reports to determine coverage eligibility.
- Report findings to Agents prior to accepting, modifying, or rejecting based on finds from risk assessment and policy application review.
- Collaborating to determine appropriate coverages and evaluate policy options, while adhering to Underwriting Guidelines and binding authorities.
- Work with Agents to identify available coverages, appropriate premiums, and necessary terms for new business, policy renewals, and endorsements.
- Assist Agents through education on the impacts of specific coverage changes and guideline amendments.
- Provide general underwriting support, and clerical duties.
